NorState FCU added a third coin sorter in their Fort Kent location, and the receiving charity for 2016 will be the Heather & Liam Connection and Aroostook Autism Awareness Support Group. “After much consideration, NorState’s management team decided that Autism awareness and support would be our focus for the new year and our financial contribution from the fees collected from the users of the coin sorters in all three locations would benefit these local charities,” stated NorState Marketing Executive, Denise Duperre. Minimal fees are charged for the use of the coin sorter. 2% for NFCU members, and 5% for non-members, so pennies on the dollar, and all proceeds benefit a local charity.
